

Voting in New Hampshire



1. Are you eligible to vote?

- a. 18 or older
- b. US citizen
- c. “Domiciled” in town or city ward where voting
 - » Domicile is “that place, to which upon temporary absence, a person has the intention of returning”
 - » One can only be domiciled in one place for voting purposes

2. Do you have proof of eligibility?

- a. Government issued photo ID - driver’s license, passport
- b. Proof of domicile - rental agreement or current utility bill, tax forms
- c. Other - <https://www.sos.nh.gov/sites/g/files/ehbemt561/files/documents/2023-02/5-2023-voter-id-explanatory-document.pdf>
- d. If not, may be able to establish eligibility by signing affidavit(s)

3. How do I register to vote?

- a. By visiting your city or town clerk’s office and completing a voter registration form in person
- b. By attending session held by local Supervisors of the Checklist
 - » By law they meet once, 6-13 days before an election, contact town or city to determine when meeting
- c. You may also register to vote at the polls on election day
- d. Requesting registration via mail by checking appropriate box on absentee ballot application

5. Can I vote absentee?

- a. Physical disability
- b. Religious observance
- c. Absence from city or town on the day of election
- d. Employment obligations, which include:
 - » care of children or infirm adults, with or without compensation

6. How do I vote absentee?

- a. Complete paper form in person at city or town clerk's office
 - » Complete Absentee Ballot request form at: <https://lebanonnh.gov/562/General-Information>
 - » If you are not registered to vote, check the second box in Section I ("I am absent from..."), which will trigger the office sending you registration papers
- b. Can mail/fax/hand deliver to clerk:
