

Finding Community Partners at Dartmouth

Dartmouth Health Center for Advancing Rural Health Equity (CARHE)

In January 2022, a group of Dartmouth College, Dartmouth Health, and community leaders came together to lay the foundation for CARHE. The group grappled with the fact that Northern New England rural populations experience worse outcomes compared to urban counterparts. Despite the international reputation held by Dartmouth College and Dartmouth Health researchers, educators, and clinicians, local populations often do not receive the health care they need, nor do they live in conditions that promote optimal health.

CARHE was created to bring researchers, clinicians, and educators together with community experts to work and learn together, to make sure that people in rural areas have the chance to live healthy lives.

CARHE supports community engaged partnerships to advance health and health equity. Examples of CARHE activities include: learning and training sessions to increase knowledge about health equity, rural health, and evidence-based interventions to improve partnerships; project management for health-equity focused improvements; and advocacy efforts in support of rural health.

CARHE can provide support to clinicians, researchers, and student service learners seeking advice about community-based experts in our region and high-quality engagement practices.

Identifying and Engaging Community Partners

CARHE is committed to supporting partnerships, bringing people together to work, learn, and advocate for change so people living in rural areas have the chance to be as healthy as possible.
